Queensland Parkinson's Project (QPP) is a multi-institutional research collaborative dedicated to understanding the causes of Parkinson's disease (PD) and related disorders ***INCLUDING DYSTONIA*** and facilitating the development of effective treatments.

The cause of most cases of these conditions is unknown but is thought to involve many different genetic and environmental factors each contributing a little towards the development of the disease. Determining the factors responsible relies on large study groups and complex analytical methods. QPP are world leaders in these approaches and are currently running a variety of studies.
